



Footfall Last 12 Months | Clapham BID






Clapham BID footfall down 3% QoQ in Q1 2024 at 79,634

Average footfall for Clapham BID in Q1 (the last full quarter) is tracking at 79,634 unique visitors per day. This is a decrease of 3% on the equivalent value in Q4, and a rise of 16% year-on-year to Q1 2023.

Clapham BID currently attracts the highest footfall among all centres measured, and its average daily unique footfall is 39% above the overall Clapham mean.


The highest footfall period in the 12 months to the last quarter was Q4 2023 at 82,437 daily visitors

Average daily footfall for Clapham BID in Q1 was 79,634 unique visitors per day. This is a decrease of 3% on the preceding quarter, Q4, where average daily footfall was 82,437. It is also up 16% on Q1 2023, last year.

In the 12 months to the last full quarter, the period with the highest average daily footfall was Q4, at 82,437, and the lowest was Q3 at 70,373.

Thursdays see highest weekday footfall of 79,267 in Q1 2024


Clapham BID attracted an average unique weekday footfall of 74,992 visitors, and an average weekend footfall of 91,237 in Q1 2024, the most recent full quarter.

The highest weekday by volume is Thursday, at 79,267. That's 6% above the Mon-Fri mean. Conversely, the weekday with the lowest footfall is Wednesday at 5% below the average.

Weekends average 91,237 across both days - that's 22% higher than on weekdays. Back in Q1 2019, the highest weekday for footfall was also Thursday, and weekdays together attracted 12% more footfall than on weekends.

The peak hour for weekday footfall in Q1 2024 is 08:00


The hourly footfall trend on weekdays changes with time. Seasonal differences may reflect how visitors use centres across Clapham through the year.

For Clapham BID in Q1 2024, the peak time for footfall was 08:00 with an average of 11,401 unique visitors per hour. Last year in Q1 2023, the peak times for footfall were 08:00 and 19:00. Comparing the profile between Q1 this year and last we can see that the trend has diverged by 11%, suggesting changing reasons for use.

Weekend peak time is 16:00 with 9,661 unique visitors.


The reasons that visitors use centres on weekends vs weekdays differ. For Clapham BID on weekends in Q1 2024, the peak time to visit was 16:00 with an average of 9,661 unique visitors per hour.


This then proceeds to trend down 31% to 7,367 by 18:00. The weekend footfall hourly trend in Q1 is very similar to its shape last year in 2023 with a 85% correlation - even if absolute footfall volumes may differ.



Hotspots are less specific in Q1

Clapham BID centre usage is 2% more spread out than in it was in Q4, and visits are less concentrated around key hotspots. The equivalent measure is up on the breadth of centre usage seen last year in Q1 2023. In terms of area profile, there is a positive resemblance (53%) to visit density during the same quarter last year, but this has in itself recovered over the course of Q1.


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Footfall Last 12 Months | Clapham Common






Clapham Common footfall down 5% QoQ in Q1 2024 at 34,939

Average footfall for Clapham Common in Q1 (the last full quarter) is tracking at 34,939 unique visitors per day. This is a decrease of 5% on the equivalent value in Q4, and a rise of 46% year-on-year to Q1 2023.

Clapham Common currently attracts the 2nd highest footfall among all centres measured, and its average daily unique footfall is 39% below the overall Clapham mean.


The highest footfall period in the 12 months to the last quarter was Q4 2023 at 36,964 daily visitors

Average daily footfall for Clapham Common in Q1 was 34,939 unique visitors per day. This is a decrease of 5% on the preceding quarter, Q4, where average daily footfall was 36,964. It is also up 46% on Q1 2023, last year.

In the 12 months to the last full quarter, the period with the highest average daily footfall was Q4, at 36,964, and the lowest was Q2 at 26,585.

Wednesdays see highest weekday footfall of 37,109 in Q1 2024


Clapham Common attracted an average unique weekday footfall of 32,754 visitors, and an average weekend footfall of 40,400 in Q1 2024, the most recent full quarter.

The highest weekday by volume is Wednesday, at 37,109. That's 13% above the Mon-Fri mean. Conversely, the weekday with the lowest footfall is Monday at 5% below the average.

Weekends average 40,400 across both days - that's 23% higher than on weekdays. Back in Q1 2019, the highest weekday for footfall was Thursday, and weekdays together attracted 8% more footfall than on weekends.

The peak hour for weekday footfall in Q1 2024 is 16:00


The hourly footfall trend on weekdays changes with time. Seasonal differences may reflect how visitors use centres across Clapham through the year.

For Clapham Common in Q1 2024, the peak time for footfall was 16:00 with an average of 4,666 unique visitors per hour. Last year in Q1 2023, the peak times for footfall were 08:00 and 15:00. Comparing the profile between Q1 this year and last we can see that the trend has diverged by 7%, suggesting consistent reasons for use.

Weekend peak time is 16:00 with 3,671 unique visitors.


The reasons that visitors use centres on weekends vs weekdays differ. For Clapham Common on weekends in Q1 2024, the peak time to visit was 16:00 with an average of 3,671 unique visitors per hour.


This then proceeds to trend down 28% to 2,870 by 18:00. The weekend footfall hourly trend in Q1 is very similar to its shape last year in 2023 with a 81% correlation - even if absolute footfall volumes may differ.



Hotspots are more focused in Q1

Clapham Common centre usage is 3% less spread out than in it was in Q4, and visits are more concentrated around key hotspots. The equivalent measure is still down on the breadth of centre usage seen last year in Q1 2023. In terms of area profile, there is a fair resemblance (44%) to visit density during the same quarter last year, and this has in itself recovered over the course of Q1.
